**ADULTS WITH INCAPACITY (SCOTLAND) ACT 2000**

*An Act of the Scottish Parliament*

**Recognition of 'Foreign' Powers of Attorney**

I, Fiona Brown, Public Guardian for Scotland, hereby advise that interpretation of Scottish legislation suggests a non-Scottish Power of Attorney is automatically valid in Scotland. There is no provision for having a non-Scottish Power of Attorney endorsed for use in Scotland; this action being unnecessary.
