ADULTS WITH INCAPACITY (SCOTLAND) ACT 2000

An Act of the Scottish Parliament

Recognition of 'Foreign' Powers of Attorney

I, Fiona Brown, Public Guardian for Scotland, hereby advise that interpretation of Scotlish legislation suggests a non-Scotlish Power of Attorney is automatically valid in Scotland. There is no provision for having a non-Scotlish Power of Attorney endorsed for use in Scotland; this action being unnecessary.
